Testing Options:

_____ **Fecal Flotation (\$19.00):** checks for worms in stool

_____ **Fecal Wet Mount (18.00):** checks for certain bacteria and parasites in the stool

Please note that intestinal parasites have the potential to be transmitted to you and your children

Heartworm Test Options: checks the blood for the presence of heartworms and ensures current preventatives are effective

_____ **Idexx Snap 4 HW Test (\$27.50 + \$12.50 Blood collection fee)-** tests for heartworms, Lyme Disease, Anaplasma & Ehrlichia

_____ **Heska Occult Test (\$16.50 + \$12.50 Blood collection fee)-** only tests for heartworms

Vaccinations:

_____ **DA2P (\$16.50):** Prevents distemper, adenovirus, virus & parvoenteritis virus.

_____ **Rabies (\$16.50):** required by the state to prevent rabies infection

_____ **Leptospirosis (\$16.50):** prevents contagious bacteria that damages the kidneys.

_____ **Bordetella (\$16.50):** prevents the contagious infection causing kennel cough.

_____ **Crotalus Atrox Toxoid (\$18.00):** decreases the effects of rattle snake & copper head venom.

_____ **Microchip (\$45.00):** to ensure your pet's safety.
